You have submitted an application to the Erasmus+ Programme, 2017 call for proposals for the action specified above. The call for proposals closed on 28/02/2017 - 12:00 (CET/CEST). The Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA) received 168 applications for this call. Out of these 168 applications submitted, 20 have been selected for funding and 2 have been placed on a reserve list.

I am writing to inform you about the selection decision taken by the Head of Department of the Agency, acting in her capacity as authorising officer, based on the recommendations of an Evaluation Committee assisted by external experts.

I regret to inform you that your application has **not** been selected for EU co-funding. It received **73**/100 points however given the available budget only applications with a score of 78/100 points and above could be selected for funding.
