Memorandum of Understanding

 - Promote commitment to this evaluation among all constituencies of my institution (including staff and students)
 - Conduct a self-evaluation process within my institution following the Guidelines provided, and deliver a subsequent report to the evaluation team
 - Organise the required meetings with the university's internal and external stakeholders
 during the two site visits according to the draft programme of the visits agreed between
 the university and the team





















- Support UEFISCDI in making logistical arrangements for the accommodation, meals and local transportation of the experts during the two site visits as indicated in the Financial Guidelines of the project
- Liaise with the IEP/EUA and UEFISCDI secretariat whenever necessary during the evaluation process, so to ensure a smooth running of the evaluation
- Providing feedback during the post-evaluation workshop, which will take place in September 2014;
- Participating in the project final dissemination conference, which will be organised in October/November 2014.
