The goal of ICCCC is to bring together international researchers and scientists from academia and industry to present and discuss — in a collegial and stimulating environment — their latest research findings on a wide range of topics in **computer science, communications, networking, and control systems**.

ICCCC 2026 continues the tradition of excellence and innovation in computational sciences initiated by its founders.

Dedication:

This edition of ICCCC is dedicated to the memory of Academician Grigore C. Moisil (1906–1973), the founding father of Romanian computer science and an important contributor to the development of non-Chrysippian logics. A visionary mathematician, he laid the theoretical foundations for the advancement of informatics and logical systems in Romania. His legacy continues to inspire generations of researchers and innovators in the field of computational sciences.

Topics of Interest

The conference covers, but is not limited to, the following main areas:

- T1:** Complex Control and Communication Systems;
- T2:** Artificial Intelligence, with particular emphasis on Deep Learning;
- T3:** Soft Computing, with particular emphasis on Fuzzy Sets and Systems.

Submission Guidelines & Platform

All papers must be original and not simultaneously submitted to another journal or conference.

The following submission requirements apply:

- Each paper must consist of a minimum of 8 pages, recommended between 8 and 20 pages;
- For the review process, papers must be submitted in PDF format (A4 size, one column);
- After acceptance and presentation at the conference, authors will be requested to provide the

LaTeX source files (for IJCCC publication preparation);

- Papers must describe original, previously unpublished, and completed research, not currently under review elsewhere, addressing cutting-edge developments in areas related to computer science, communications, networking, and control systems;
- Each author may submit a maximum of two papers;
- Manuscripts not following these submission instructions may be returned to authors without review.

Submission Platform

All papers must be submitted directly through the IJCCC submission system:

Submissions must be made to the special section “*ICCCC 2026*”.

When submitting, please include in the *Comments for the Editor* field the following note:

“Submitted for ICCCC 2026, Topic [T1/T2/T3 – indicate the corresponding topic].”

All subsequent versions of the same paper (draft, camera-ready, and post-presentation revised version) must be uploaded under the same paper ID, in the *Discussion* section of the IJCCC platform.

Please do not create a new submission for revised or final versions.

All communication between authors, reviewers, and editors regarding ICCCC 2026 will be conducted exclusively through the IJCCC platform.

Authors are kindly asked not to send papers or correspondence by email; all messages, revisions, and notifications will be exchanged within the *Discussion* section of the IJCCC system.

- Notification of Draft Acceptance / Rejection: **May 31, 2026**;
- Camera-Ready Paper Submission (for Conference Presentation) (via [IJCCC](#) Platform): **June 1–15, 2026**;
- Notification of Final Acceptance (for Presentation): **June 30, 2026**;
- Conference Fee Payment: **July 1–31, 2026**;
- Registration Form Submission: until **July 31, 2026**;
- Conference Dates: **October 6–9, 2026**;
- Final Submission of Papers Accepted and Presented at ICCCC to [IJCCC](#) (for Publication): **October 19 – November 16, 2026**.

Notes:

- Only original and unpublished papers are accepted;
- All submissions will undergo a **two-stage peer review process**:
 - Draft Evaluation: assessing relevance, quality, and structure.
 - Final Evaluation: determining acceptance for conference presentation and eligibility for publication.
- Papers accepted and presented at ICCCC 2026 must upload their final revised version to the IJCCC platform after the conference and will be further reviewed by IJCCC editors and reviewers prior to publication.
- Authors will be notified by **November 30, 2026**, regarding the final allocation of accepted papers to IJCCC Vol. 20 No. 6 (2026) and Vol. 21 Nos. 1–6 (2027).

Post-Conference Submission Reminder: The final submission (October 19–November 16, 2026) must include the LaTeX source files and publication forms required by [IJCCC](#)
